# FIREFIGHTER INTERN PROGRAM

The program is designed to offer an opportunity to gain training and experience for individuals with an Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) certificate who have completed an accredited Fire Academy or possess a Firefighter 1 certification. Firefighter Intern is a temporary, unpaid, non-benefited position.

## SCHEDULE

- Interns shall be assigned to a specific shift and station. The corresponding Captain of the assigned shift/station will be the intern's immediate supervisor and mentor.
- The intern may work 24-hour shifts per duty day. 0800-0800hrs.
- To stay active in the program, interns shall work no less than three (3) shifts per month with a maximum of five (5), unless approved by a program manager.
- One year commitment is required. A possible one-year extension may be granted after an evaluation.

## QUALIFICATIONS

- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Be a high school graduate or possess a G.E.D.
- Possess a Class C Driver's License.
- Possess a valid CPR certification for Health Care Providers and a California Certified EMT1.
- Possess a certification from a California State Fire Accredited Regional Training Program/ Academy or possess a current California State Fire Training Firefighter 1 certification.
- All candidates may be screened in the following: oral interview, physical agility test/current CPAT, background investigation, and medical exam (recent medical exam within the last year may be sufficient).

## ROLE

- The intern shall be the fourth member of a crew in a training/learning role. He/she shall not be used or recognized as filling a paid professional position/seat, as per minimum staffing stated in the El Dorado Hills Professional Firefighters' MOU.
- The intern shall not be used for any high-risk firefighting activities on an incident (including interior structure fires).
- When not responding to emergencies, the employee will perform a variety of tasks in and around the District and community.

## OPPORTUNITIES

- Obtain Firefighter 1 certification after 1 year of employment (must have completed the California State Fire Accredited Regional Training Program/Academy).
- Multiple base-level certifications sponsored by the Department. For example: Confined Space Awareness, Low Angle Rescue Operations, Rescue Intervention Crew Operations, etc.
- This is a temporary, unpaid, non-benefited position, however, Firefighter Interns may be considered for future employment as a full-time professionals.
- Obtain valuable time and experience toward building a professional resume.
- Mentorship, direction, and assistance in developing as a professional Firefighter.
